



Operational Delivery Profession (ODP) Qualifications: Pre – Enrolment Guide



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About Our Qualifications





ODP, we either work directly with the public or we offer support to those who do.

In studying an ODP qualification, you will be building upon the skills you require for your role and gaining new and transferable skills.



Our qualifications are self-managed and the learning is carried out online, so you can choose when and where you study.



There are different types of qualification assessments depending on the level you choose, including exams, assignments or workbooks.



Depending on the level of qualification vou choose, you will have either 12 or 18 months to complete your qualification.



There are no entry level requirements for our qualifications and it doesn't matter what previous qualifications/study experience you have.

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First Steps - Research

Before considering enrolling for a qualification, it is always a good idea to do your research. Find out as much information as possible about the programme, **before** signing up. This will enable you to make an informed choice as to which qualification is right for you.

- ensure your manager is aware that they will need to support you with your qualification



Finally, In terms of applying for any ODP qualifications the best thing you can do is refer to your own department's process for this, as everyone has slightly different guidance in place.

As ODP qualifications are based around your job role, we advise you choose a suitable starting level for your role. This is to ensure that you have the necessary work experience to enable you to complete your tasks/tests and meet the required assessment criteria
